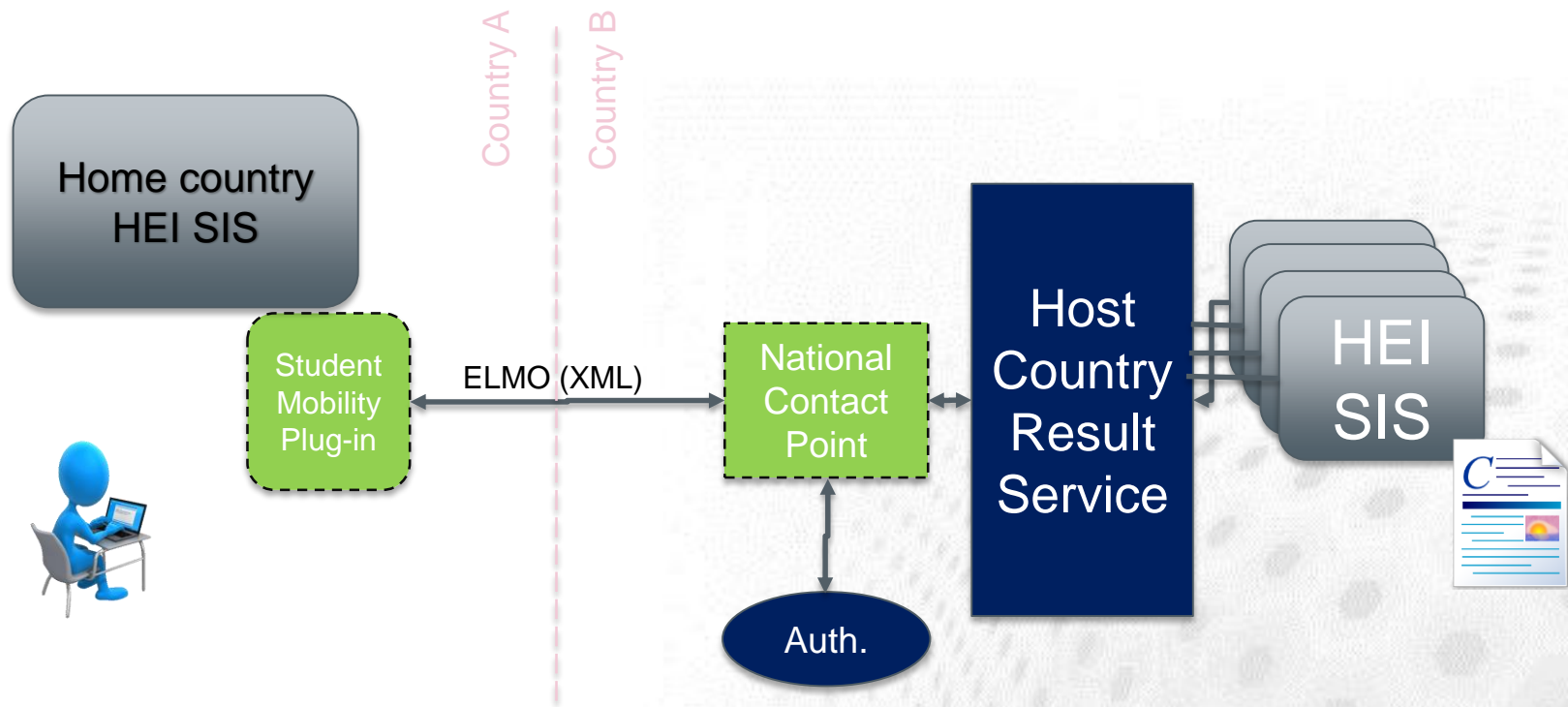


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Timeline

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Field trial ongoing

- Finland, Italy, Norway, Sweden in production
- Italian SMP ready for the HEIs
- Danish NCP in production in December
- Not that much exchange between Nordic countries
- Usage last summer, first phase:

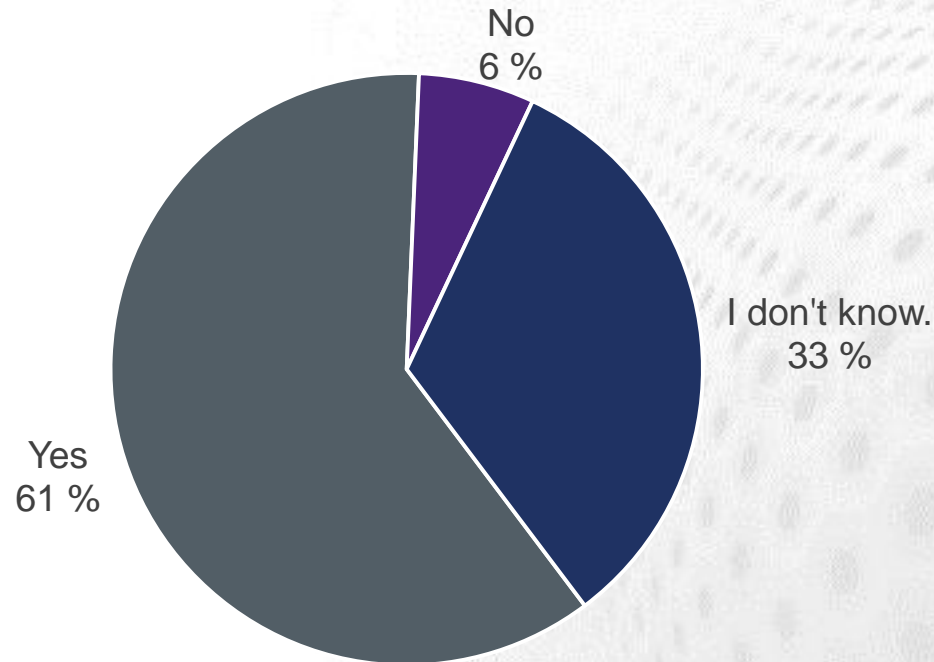

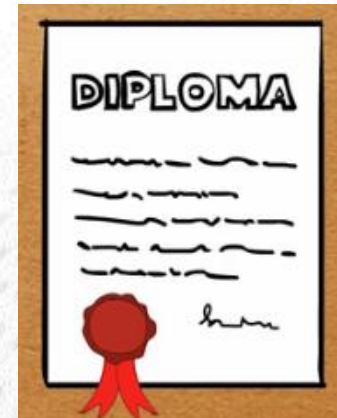


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Next steps

- Field trial continues until summer 2017
- New partners already joining the network
 - Duo (Netherlands), VTAC (Australia)
 - Spain China, USA....
 - EWP, ESC, DS, eIDAS (EU projects)
- EMREX 2.0 project application to come
 - Add new EU members to the EMREX network
 - Collaborate with non-EU members to join the network
 - Improve the solution and add new functionality (e.g. for admission)
- Internal mobility in Poland and Finland

- Other use scenarios – EMREX a building block
 - Internal national mobility
 - Admission to educational institutions
 - Recruitment for jobs
 - Validation of degrees and diplomas
 - Informal learning



- Further steps
 - Expand to other countries
 - More automatization of recognition, admission, recruitment, certification etc.
- Issues to be worked out in a broader perspective
 - Long-lived authentication services for students leaving academia
 - Common eID for EU
