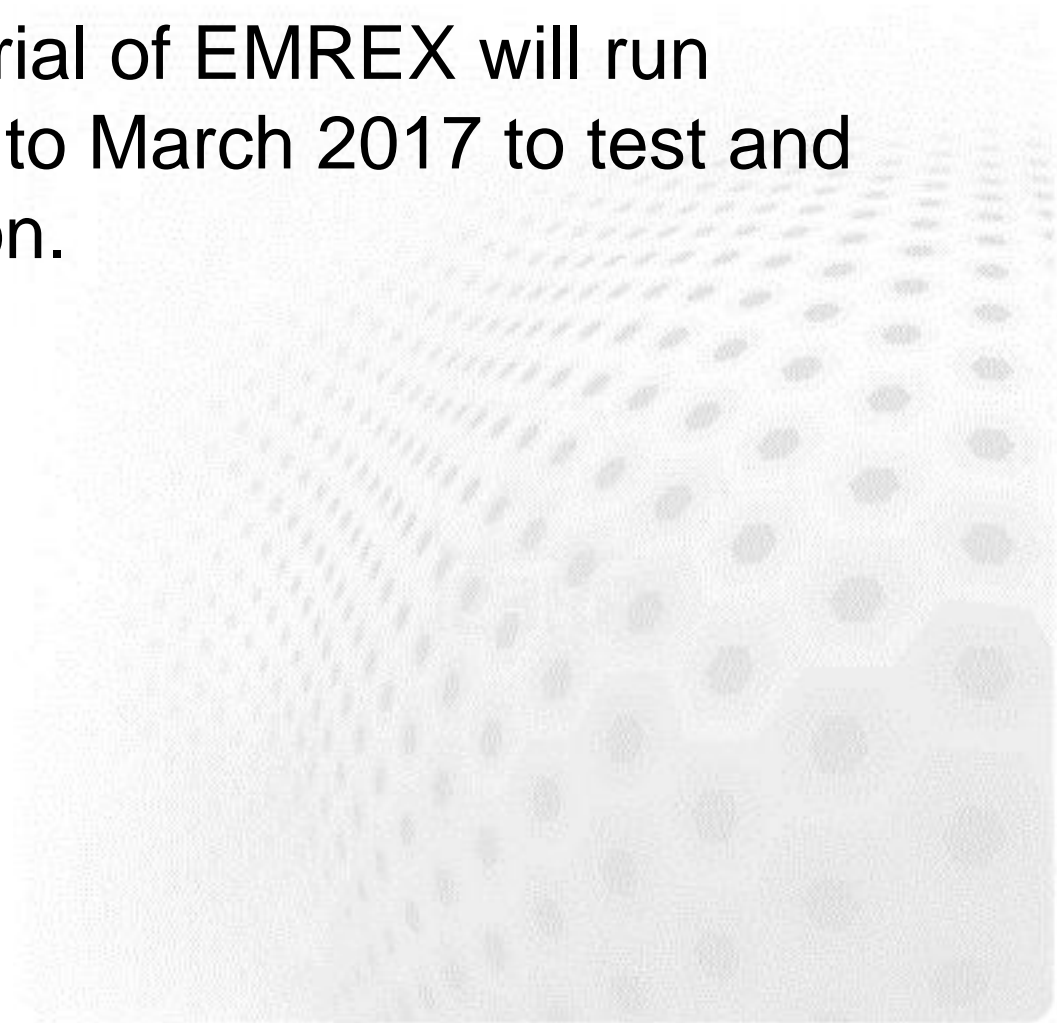

Field Trial

A live going Field Trial of EMREX will run from January 2016 to March 2017 to test and evaluate the solution.





ERASMUS+

Why a trial?

- Test and evaluate these new, digital systems.
- How do different target groups experience the system? Students, administrators, technical personnel.
- To address possible obstacles.



ERASMUS+

Countries involved in Field Trial 2016

NCP, sending information from receiving institution.

Finland, Norway, Italy, Denmark (from June 2016), Sweden.

SMP, collecting information to “home” university.

Students in these countries may during the above mentioned period log into their student portal at their home university and collect study achievements from the receiving university.



ERASMUS+

EMREX small pilot (test group)

Pilot late November - early December 2015

Small group of students from Norway that studied in Sweden or Finland during 2015, tries out the Norwegian SMP and its ability to connect with the Swedish and Finish NCP's.



ERASMUS+

The actual trial 2016

- Run from January 2016 to March 2017.
- Includes students that have studied in Sweden, Norway, Finland, Denmark and Italy.
- Can also include students with results from 2015 (or earlier).
- In some countries also might include transferring of results between universities within the country.



ERASMUS+

Institutions included in Field Trial (this far...)

Denmark- From summer 2016, all universities for incoming and outgoing students.

Italy- University of Verona and Siena for incoming and outgoing students.

Finland- all universities for incoming students. Hanken School of Economics, Åbo Akademi University, Häme University of Applied Sciences, Oulu University of Applied Sciences, Helsinki University for outgoing students.

Norway- All universities and university colleges for both incoming- and outgoing students.

Sweden- All universities and university colleges for incoming students.
